Class Supply List: Laura Heine Collage Workshop

In this class, we will learn how to make one of the Laura Heine Collage Quilts. We will be using Laura Heine's Teeny Tiny pattern, and everyone will be working to create their own style. I would avoid the Teeny Tiny patterns that use the small strips. That is a different technique we will not be covering. You will learn why we use Steam-A-Seam 2 for applique pieces and master the cutting and trimming of applique pieces. We will be working on the collage part of the pattern, but I will give ideas for finishing your project.

SUPPLIES:


- Teeny Tiny Pattern such as #5 (Pincushion- Sewing machine- Dress Form) or another similar Teeny Tiny pattern.
- Paper scissors
 - Karen Kay Buckley medium fine point handle scissors are recommended, (Blue Handle), or NEW Laura Heine Serrated Scissors
- #2 Pencil for tracing your pattern.
- Applique pressing sheet 17" x 24". I carry Laura Heine Collage mat.
- Painters Tape to hold pattern down.
- Pattern Ease 5/8-yard.
- 3-4 yards of 12" Steam a Seam 2 (no substitutes)
- Small rotary cutter, mat, and ruler Stiletto
- Backing: refer to pattern for exact yardage
- Binding (1/2yard), frame or stretcher canvas (16' x 20" for finishing).
- DRY Iron

USING YOUR OWN FABRICS: refer to the pattern you are using to decide what fabrics you need.

- Good selection of scraps, cutables and underlays
- 5 10 pieces of light blender fabrics to use for the background of the collage (if using five you will need a piece about 6" x WOF of each). If using more pieces, be sure to have enough to cover the 19" X 23".
- *Optional*: Kits, patterns, Laura Heine Collage Mat, scissors, Laura Heine Pattern Ease are available for purchase. Contact Cathy to order.





Monthly Raffle was won by Jan McBain.


Name badge drawing was won by Julie Trollinger.

Fall Flowers BOM August 2025



Fabric A (flower petals) 4 @ 5" square, same color
 Red, dark yellow, gold, orange, burgundy—any fall flower color
 Fabric B (Background) 12 @ 1.5" squares
 Natural/off-white

Fabric C (flower center) 4 @ 1.5" squares*

Brown, green, gold, black

Draw (or press) a diagonal line on the back of each 1.5" square. Place three background squares on each petal.

Place one center square on the remaining corner of petal.

/ \ (Snowball effect)

Trim outside of each corner seam. Press outward.

Join squares together with C toward center, being very careful to match seams. (I pressed these seams open.)

Square to 9.5".
