Featuring 163 years of quilting history, the collection includes early utilitarian quilts from the 19th century alongside contemporary art quilts, including award-winning pieces from regional and national exhibitions. Each quilt highlights the evolution of design, technique, and cultural storytelling, offering insight into the changing role of quilting in American life. The quilts in this exhibit were crafted by both modern quilters and quilting guilds, using both modern and

vintage patterns and materials, as well as family heirloom quilts, handed down generation to generation over the course of decades and even centuries.

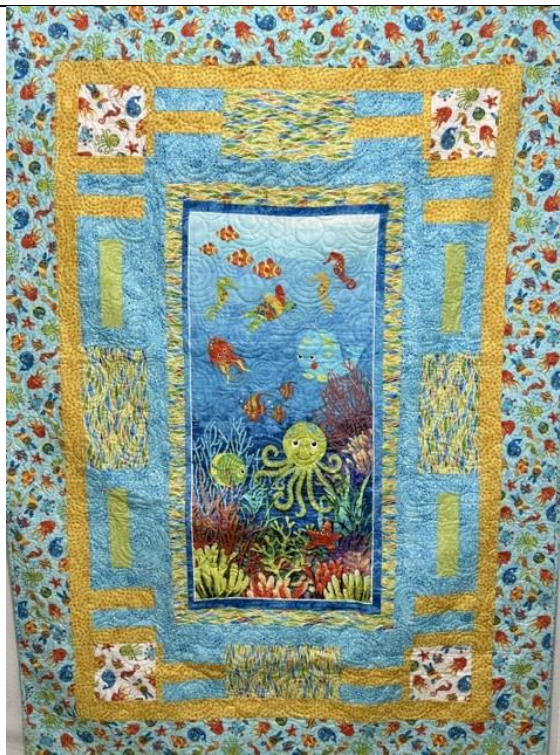

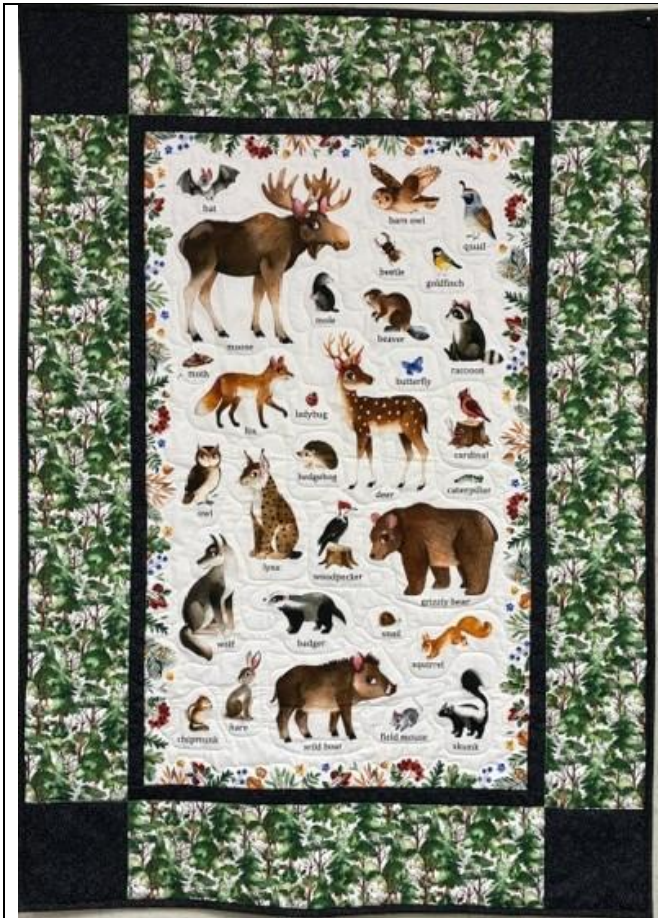

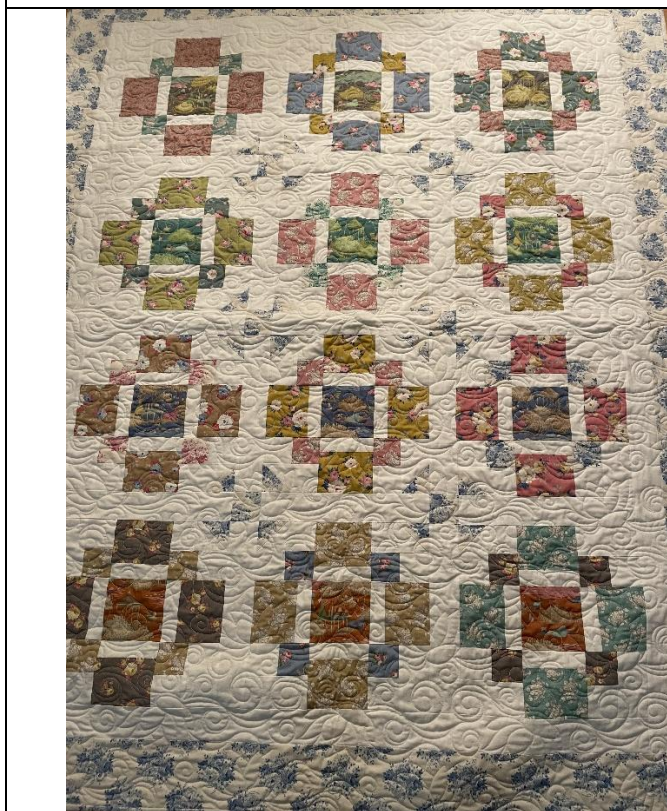
