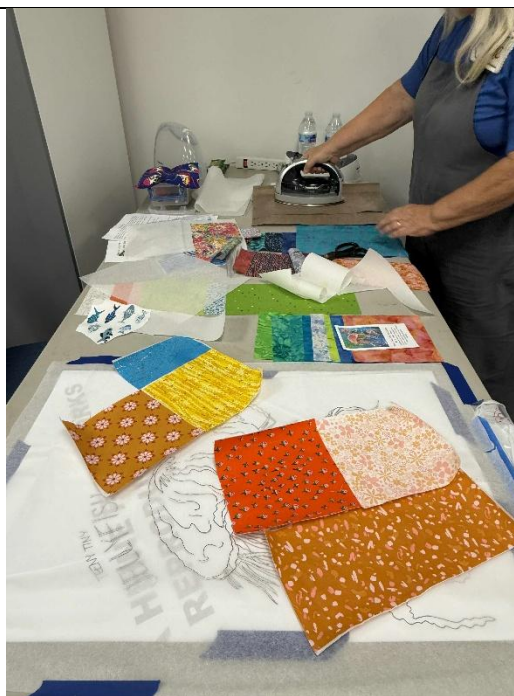


August Collage Workshop

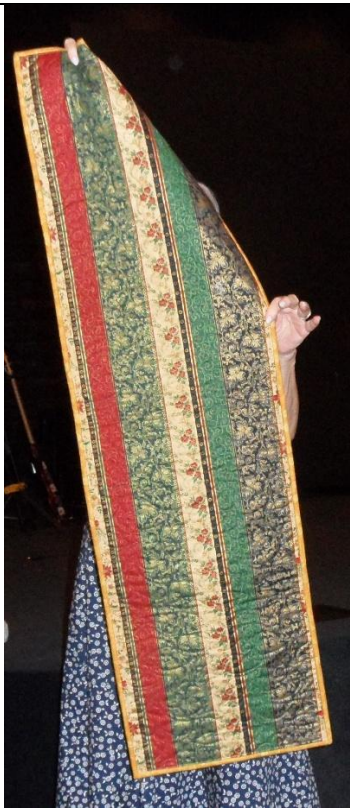

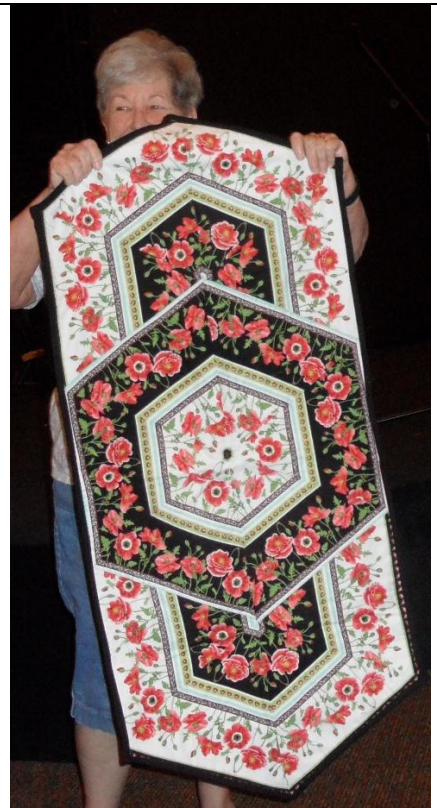

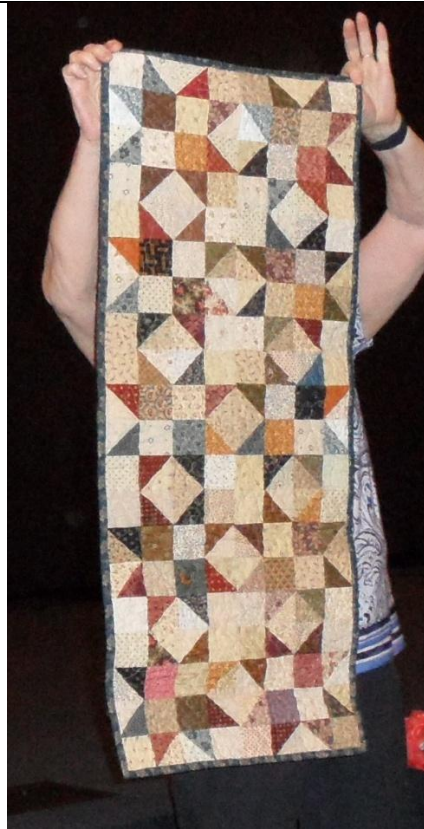

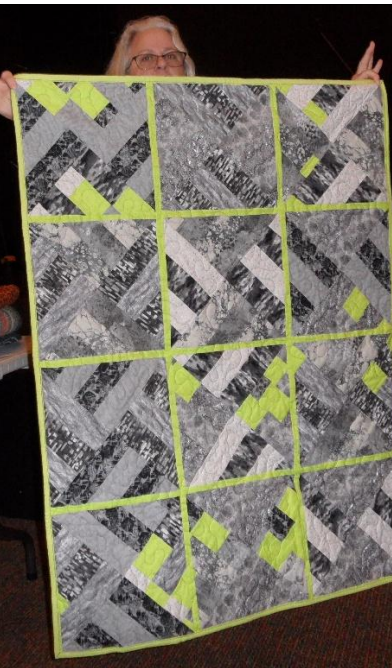
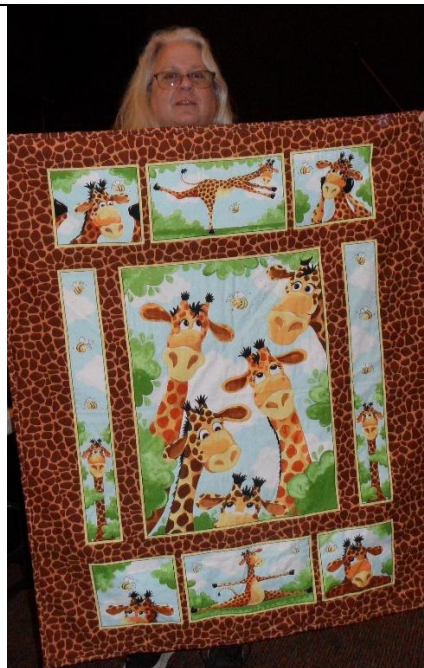
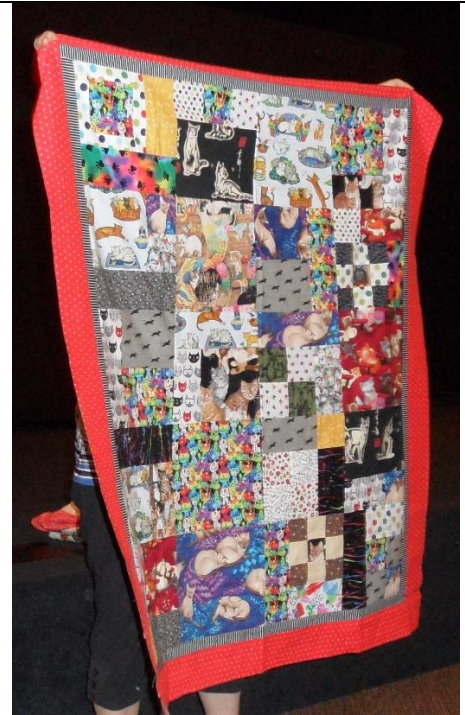

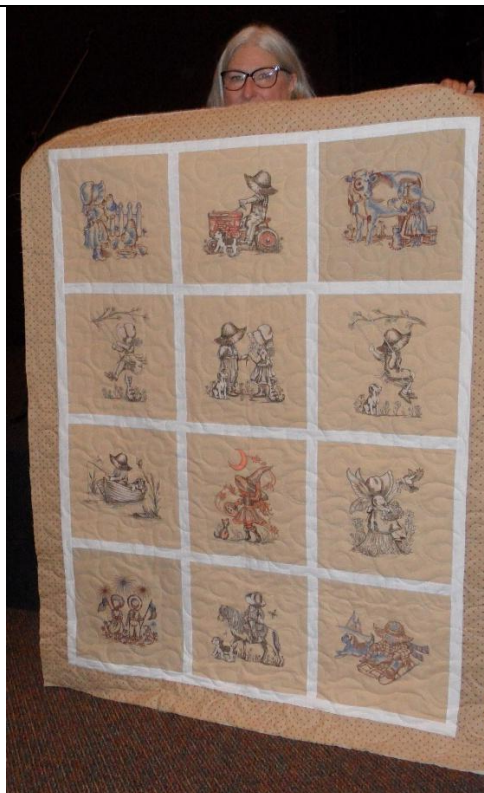

August 12, 2025
