Continuation of the Mystery Quilt using the pieces built in Clue #1 and Clue #2 with the cut pieces in Clue #5 and then combining both sets in Clue #6.



CLUE #5 (instructions from Cindy Carter)

It is critical that your seam is 1/4".

Please sew a couple of each unit and make sure that it measures correctly before continuing.

Finished units should measure 3.5" x 5.5"

	Comfort	Twin	Full
<p>A. 3.5" 9-patch and 2.5" x 3.5" background fabric rectangle <i>Press to the rectangle.</i></p> 	(64) Units	(80) Units	(100) Units
<p>B. 2.5" 4-Patch and 2.5" x 3.5" background fabric rectangle <i>Press to the rectangle.</i></p> 	(64) Units	(80) Units	(100) Units
VERY IMPORTANT			

Make sure upper right corner is a background fabric square!			
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CLUE #6 (instructions from Cindy Carter)

It is critical that your seam is 1/4".

Please sew a couple of each unit and make sure that it measures correctly before continuing.

Finished units should measure 5.5" square.

DOUBLE CHECK –

- Is the upper right hand corner in background fabric?
- Are seams pressed AWAY from the 9-Patch block?

	Comfort	Twin	Full
A. Sew units from Clue #5 together according to the picture. <i>IMPORTANT: - Orient block so it looks like the picture. Check pressing.</i>	(64) Units	(80) Units	(100) Units
