### CLUE #7 (instructions from Cindy Carter)



It is critical that your seam is 1/4".

Please sew a couple of each unit and make sure that it measures correctly before continuing.

Joins units from Clue #4 and Clue #6.

Finished units should measure 5.5" x 20.5". Press to the Center Rectangle (Clue #4).

**IMPORTANT – 4-Patches with light in the corner need to be on the UPPER OUTSIDE corners.**

<p>A. Sew two (2) from Clue #6 and one (1) from Clue #4, nesting the seams. <i>Press to Clue #6 rectangle.</i></p> 	<p>(30) Units</p> <p>Note: Totals have been adjusted from the original pattern (was 64).</p>	<p>(38) Units</p> <p>Note: Totals have been adjusted from the original pattern (was 80).</p>	<p>(48) Units</p> <p>Note: Totals have been adjusted from the original pattern (was 100).</p>
<p>B. Sew a 1.5" by 20.5" rectangle to Unit A (above). Make sure it is sewn next to the 4-patches. <i>Press to the rectangles.</i></p> 	(6) Units	(6) Units	(8) Units



## CLUE #8 (instructions from Cindy Carter)

It is critical that your seam is 1/4".

Please sew a couple of each unit and make sure that it measures correctly before continuing.

Joins units from Clue #2 and Clue #4.

Finished units should measure 10.5" x 20.5". Press to the outside units.

	Comfort	Twin	Full
<p>A. Sew two (2) units from Clue #4 and one (1) unit from Clue #2. Nest seams. <i>Press to Clue #4 rectangle.</i></p> 	(9) Units	(12) Units	(16) Units
<p>Sew units from Step #7A and Step 8A. Finished units should measure 20.5" square. <b>IMPORTANT – Make sure the 4-Patches are in the OUTSIDE CORNERS.</b></p> <p>A. Sew two (2) units from Clue #7A and one (1) unit from Clue #8A. Nest seams. <i>Press to Clue #7A.</i></p> 	(9) Units	(12) Units	(16) Units
