### CLUE #9 (instructions from Cindy Carter)

It is critical that your seam is 1/4".

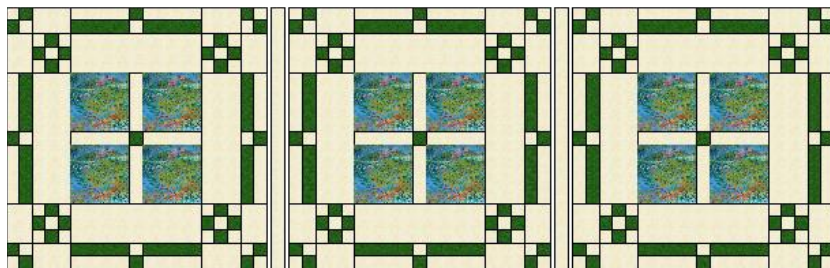
Please sew a couple of each unit and make sure that it measures correctly before continuing.

Sewing Rows (Steps A, B, C, and D follow):

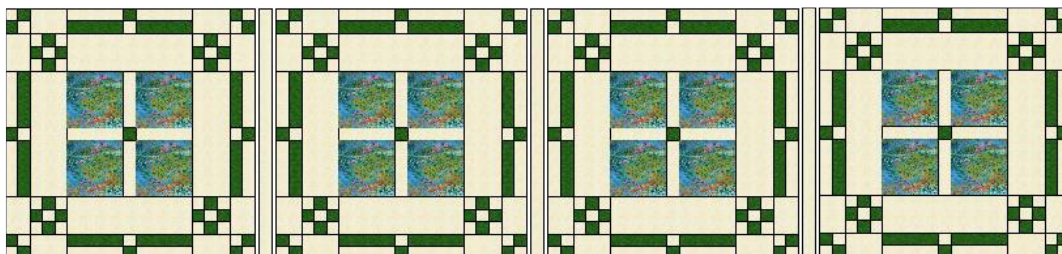
#### Step A:

Sew a 1.5" by 20.5" strip between each block. Press to the strip.

- For the Comfort Quilt (3) rows.
- For the Twin Quilt (4) rows.



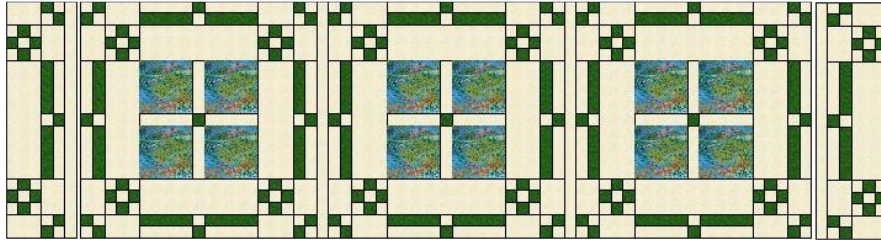
- For the Full Quilt (4) rows.



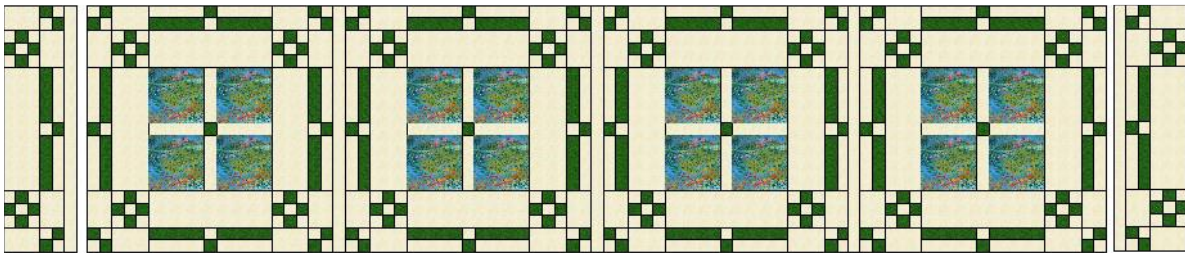
## Step B:

Sew Unit 7B to the end of each row. Press to the sashing strip.

- Comfort and Twin Quilt Rows, measure 20.5" by 74.5".



- Full Quilt Rows, measure 20.5" by 95.5".



## Step C:

Add Horizontal Sashing Strips.

Comfort Quilt – Make (4)

Twin Quilt – Make (5)

- (2) per strip. 5.5" by 1.5" background strip on each end.
- (4) per strip. 1.5" square corners stones of accent fabric.
- (3) per strip. 1.5" by 20.5" background strips.



Full Quilt – Make (5)

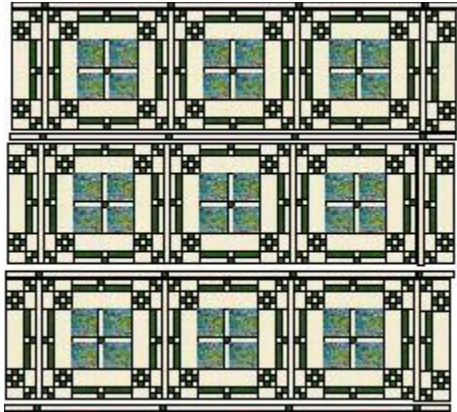
- (2) per strip. 5.5" by 1.5" background strip on each end.
- (5) per strip. 1.5" square corners stones of accent fabric.
- (4) per strip. 1.5" by 20.5" background strips.



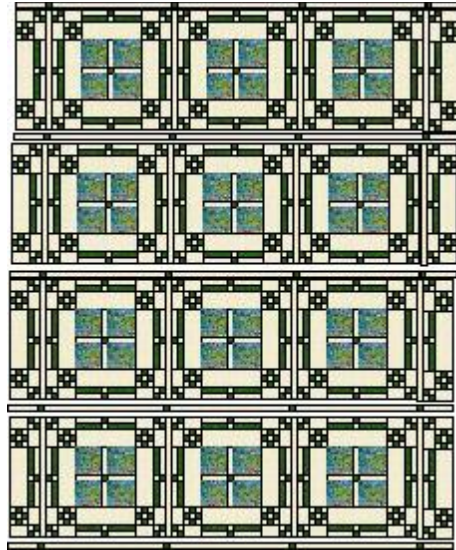
## Step D:

Join your rows and horizontal sashing strips. Press to the sashing strips.

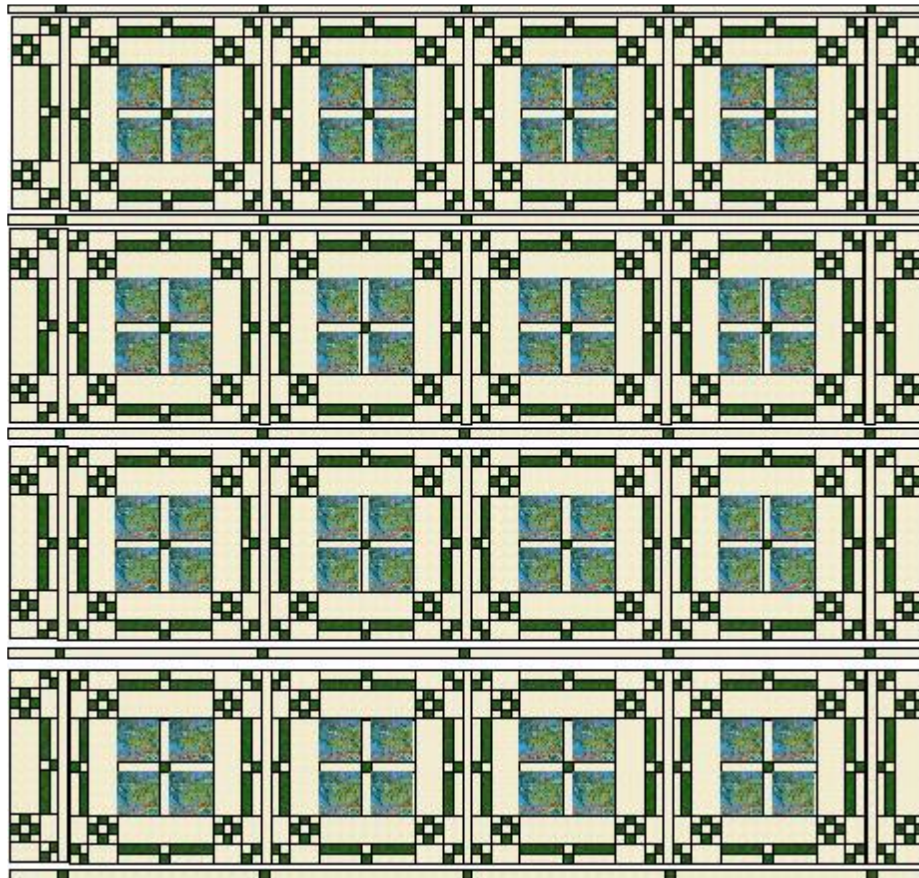
Comfort Quilt

## CLUE #10 (instructions from Cindy Carter)

It is critical that your seam is 1/4".

Make Top and Bottom Borders (Steps A, B, and C follow; Step C is optional).

### Step A:

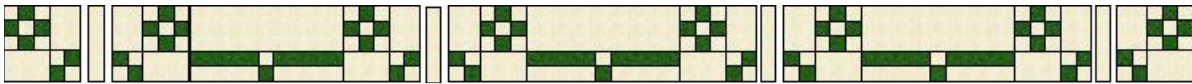
**Make sure the 9-Patch blocks are in the upper outside corner.**

For the Comfort Quilt – Make (2) of this unit

For the Twin Quilt – Make (2) of this unit

- (4) per border 5.5" by 1.5" background strips
- (3) per border Clue #7 Step A
- (2) per border Clue #6

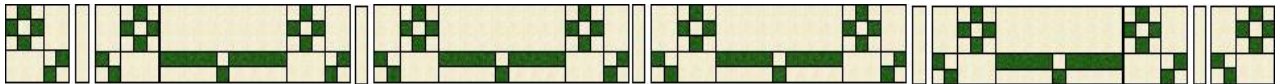
Press to the background strips.



For the Full Quilt – Make (2) of this unit

- (5) per border 5.5" by 1.5" background strips o
- (4) per border Clue #7 Step A
- (2) per border Clue #6

Press to the background strips.



**Step B:**

Sew your borders to the rest of your quilt.  
Press to the sashing strips.

**Step C.**

OPTIONAL. Outside border from Cutting Directions Step H.  
Add the 2" strips to the sides and top and bottom to extend the border.
